
Sun Country Terminal MSP



Sun Country Airlines primarily operates from Terminal 2 (Humphrey Terminal) at Minneapolis-Saint Paul International Airport (MSP). MSP is a major international airport located in Minnesota, serving the Twin Cities area, including Minneapolis and Saint Paul.

Where is Sun Country Terminal Located at MSP?

Sun Country Airlines is based in **Terminal 2** at MSP. <u>Sun Country Terminal MSP</u> is separate from the larger and busier **Terminal 1** (**Lindbergh Terminal**), which serves most of the airport's major airlines. Terminal 2 is located on the southeast side of the airport and is known for handling smaller airlines, including Sun Country, and charter flights.

Distance from Minneapolis City Center

The distance from **downtown Minneapolis** to **MSP Terminal 2** is approximately **12 miles** (19 kilometers). The drive typically takes around **20-30 minutes**, depending on traffic conditions. Similarly, the airport is roughly **15 miles** (24 kilometers) from **downtown Saint Paul**, with a travel time of approximately **20-25 minutes**.

Arrival and Departure at Sun Country Terminal 2

• Arrivals: Passengers arriving at Terminal 2 for Sun Country Airlines flights will land and proceed through customs (if an international flight) or directly to baggage claim if

- domestic. The baggage claim area is on the lower level, where transportation options like rental cars, shuttles, and public transit can be accessed.
- **Departures:** The check-in counters and security screening areas for Sun Country are conveniently located on the ground floor of Terminal 2. After passing through security, passengers can access their gates and enjoy dining options, shops, and amenities before boarding their flights.

How to Get to Sun Country Terminal from the City

Getting to Sun Country Terminal 2 from downtown Minneapolis or Saint Paul is simple, with multiple transportation options available:

1. By Car

Driving to MSP from downtown Minneapolis or Saint Paul is the most direct and flexible option. Travelers can take **Interstate 35W** or **Interstate 494**, depending on their starting point.

- From Minneapolis: Head south on I-35W, then merge onto I-494 East. Take exit 1B for Terminal 2, following signs for parking and drop-off areas.
- **From Saint Paul:** Head west on **I-94** and merge onto **MN-5 West**, then follow signs for Terminal 2 parking and passenger drop-off.

There are short-term and long-term parking options available adjacent to the terminal. You can use the **Orange Ramp** for daily parking or the **Value Parking** for extended stays.

2. By Light Rail Transit (LRT)

For a cost-effective and convenient option, travelers can use the **Metro Blue Line Light Rail** to reach Terminal 2. The light rail service connects downtown Minneapolis with both airport terminals, making it a popular choice for commuters and travelers.

• To use the Blue Line, simply board at any downtown Minneapolis stop and ride southbound toward **Mall of America**. Get off at the **Terminal 2 – Humphrey Station** stop. The ride typically takes around **25-30 minutes** from downtown.

3. By Bus

Several public bus routes serve MSP, offering another budget-friendly way to reach Terminal 2. The **Metro Transit Route 54** and **Route 109** offer connections between downtown and MSP. While buses do not stop directly at Terminal 2, passengers can transfer to the LRT at **Fort Snelling Station** or **Terminal 1** to reach Terminal 2.

4. By Taxi or Rideshare

Taxi services and rideshare companies like **Uber** and **Lyft** are widely available in the Minneapolis-Saint Paul area. A typical taxi or rideshare trip from downtown Minneapolis to Terminal 2 costs around **\$30-40** and takes about **20-25 minutes**. Designated drop-off and pick-up zones are located outside the terminal's main entrance.
